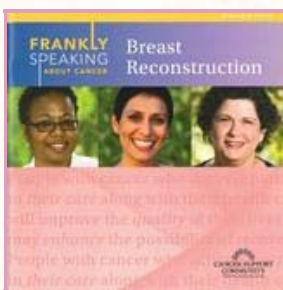
UF Health Cancer Center at Orlando Health - February Events
